Drones: Uses, Capabilities, Legal and Privacy

Considerations: Drones are quickly making their way into emergency response and emergency management. This program will include some information on the capabilities and uses of drones including, situational analysis uses during events.

The use of drone/unmanned aerial vehicles offers significant operational capabilities to the civil world in the areas of public safety, private security, medical care, and emergency management. The technology is available and expanding. Before you launch anything in the air there are some important practical aspects which should be considered. This presentation will discuss the state of the art for the technology, possible applications, civil liability, and personal freedom issues.

San Diego Wildfires:

In May 2014, several wildfires developed in San Diego County during Santa Ana wind conditions. At least eight major fires burned over 27,000 acres of land and caused over \$60 million dollars in damage.

This program will include an overview on the fires and several of the lessons learned during the response and recovery phases of the incidents.
